

STATE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER

Effective March 18-April 1, 2020, unless extended

GATHERING PLACES

- All restaurants, bars, and taverns suspend dine-in* --- pick up, delivery and drive-thru ok; Encourage online payment; no cash
- Gatherings of more than 10 individuals are prohibited (except grocery stores)
- Access to long-term care facilities guided by Medicare and Medicaid

INDIVIDUAL CARE

- Refrain from visiting nursing care facilities, assisted living facilities, and retirement homes except to provide critical assistance
- If a member of a household has tested positive for COVID-19, all members of the household should self-isolate
- Individuals 60 years or older and individuals who are immunocompromised should avoid contact with other individuals
- All individuals should avoid unnecessary travel, shopping trips and social visits
- If a member of a household tests positive for COVID-19, all members of the household are directed to self-isolate

BUSINESS RECOMMENDATIONS

- Businesses use “social distancing” (maintaining a distance of at least 6 feet between individuals)
- Employees discouraged from handling cash and credit cards
- Screen employees daily for COVID-19 symptoms and do not allow those with who are sick to stay
- Members, visitors or customers who are sick should not be allowed at your business



The order also recommends individuals refrain from visiting long-term and nursing care facilities except to provide critical assistance, and that individuals over the age of 60, or who are immunocompromised, avoid contact with others. It is also recommended that individuals avoid discretionary travel, inessential shopping trips, and social visits.



If a member of a household tests positive for COVID-19, all members of the household are directed to self-isolate.
