
COVID-19: Recommendations for 911 PSAPs



Risk Factors, Signs & Symptoms for COVID-19

- Fever OR respiratory symptoms (cough, difficulty breathing),
 AND
- Travel to China or other location with confirmed community transmission* OR close contact with a patient with known or suspected COVID-19 in the past 14 days before symptom onset.

Emergency Medical Dispatch Protocol for COVID19



Incoming call with the following complaints:

- Sick Person
- Respiratory illness
- Breathing problems and/or cough

If ALL responses are

"NO", continue with

standard EMD

procedures.



Ask the following questions:

- 1. Inquire about travel and direct exposure history.
- In the last 14 days before symptoms onset, have you traveled from China or another area with confirmed community transmission*?
- In the last 14 days before symptoms onset, have you come into close contact with a person that is under investigation or has had a positive confirmed test for COVID19 (coronavirus)?



2. Ask about signs and symptoms. Do you have a fever that has been greater than 100 4° F ?



- scene arrival.
- Patients who meet criteria should be evaluated and transported as a PUI.
- Contact local health department or Utah Department of Health with possible PUI.
